- **How to vacation-proof your house:
- --Background Information:
- *Most communities across the United States will experience a 10-18% increase in home burglaries during the months of June, July, and August, with most tending to occur in August.
- *The majority of home and apartment burglaries occur during the daytime when most people are away at work.
- *Burglars tend to choose unoccupied homes with the easiest access, the greatest amount of cover, and with the best escape routes.
- -- Practical Tips for protecting your home:
- *Notify the police if you're going to be gone longer than a week, as they will often schedule extra drive bys.
- *Have a friend or neighbor collect mail, newspapers, and fliers.
- *Put a few lights on timers so the lights go on and off at various times.
- *Double-check that door and window locks work properly and are secured when you leave your house.
- *Tell someone where you're going and leave a contact number where you can be reached.

- **Grill Safety:
- --Propane and charcoal grills should only used outdoors.
- --The grill should be placed well away from the home, deck railings, and out from under eaves and overhanging tree branches.
- --Keep children and pets away from the grill area.
- --Never leave your grill unattended.
- --Keep your grill clean by removing grease or fat build-up from the grill racks and trays below.
- --If you're using a charcoal grill, never add starter fluid to the fire.
- --If you're using a propane grill, check the gas tank hose for leaks before using the grill.
